

**ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2009 ANALYSIS OF IMMIGRATION FORM 14 DATA FROM
ALL APPROVED ENTRY/EXIT POINTS**

INTRODUCTUION

Ghana is a country with well-known and enduring migration traditions. The Ghanaian diaspora abroad is estimated at three million people. Many Ghanaians migrate within the West African sub-region, while each year very considerable numbers also migrate regularly and irregularly towards Europe and North America. Migration of skilled professionals is particularly acute in the health and education sectors while large numbers of undocumented, semi-skilled or unskilled young migrants (mostly of rural origin) venture on dangerous trips in search of better economic opportunities.

In an era of globalization, economic or labour migration is on the rise. This is due to lack of employment opportunities in developing countries and increased demands for low-wage workers in developed countries. Therefore, the youth, women and men are pursuing work in other countries in order to support themselves and their families back home. Migrant workers not only contribute to the economies of their host countries, the remittances they send home augment their home economies.

Despite encouraging economic figures, international economic migration is not strictly regulated and the maltreatment of many migrant workers is common. Migrant workers are vulnerable to harassment, exploitation and human trafficking. Part of the reason for this is that, migrant workers are not granted full citizenship in countries in which they settle.

Immigration policies have not always benefited migrant workers and there is significant racial and ethnic tension. But human trafficking and the solicitation of illegal youth workers have gone underground in a number of regions. Inter-country cooperation is needed to prevent human rights violations, trafficking and other illegal practices. Skilled migrant workers are less vulnerable to exploitation, but their departure has deprived some developing countries of valuable labour needed for their own economies. Many of these well-educated and skilled workers are the youth who make up of the world's migrants. This phenomenon is referred as the 'brain drain', where a significant segment of skilled workers leave their home country for better opportunities in other countries.

SUMMARY OF ANALYSIS OF EMBARKATION AND DISEMBARKATION DATA

The compiled statistics generated and the analysis of embarkation and disembarkation data on travelers (passengers) received from all approved entry / exit points for 2009 is detailed below.

The period under review recorded 667275 as the total migrants arrival and a total departure of 688820 representing a total arrival and departure percentage of 49% and 51% respectively.

Out of the total arrivals and departures of migrants recorded, Ghanaian migrants illustrated figures of 232381(35%) as arrival and 229516(33%) as departures .ECOWAS migrants also showed a departure figure of 208748(30%) and arrival figure of 205604 (31%) while other national migrants recorded figures of 229290(34%) and 250556(37%) as arrival and departure respectively.

The collected data were categorized into four (4) major (KIA,Afao,Elubo,Paga) and other entry / exit immigration points, and also into their means of transport as air, land and sea.

From the compilation, KIA achieved 75% (497615) arrivals and 74% (507517) departure, Elubo obtained 13% (89791) arrivals and 12% (84522) departures. Aflao received 7% (49221) for arrivals and 9% (163829) for departure. Paga had arrival value of 17493(3%) and departure of 16924 (3%). Finally other entry / exit posts demonstrated 13155(2%) for arrival and 16028(2%) for departure.

Migrants who travelled by air obtained 497615(74.57%) and 507517(73.67%) as arrival and departure respectively. Also 167642 (25.12%) was received by land as arrival and 177005 (25.70%) as departure. Finally, 2018(0.3%) and 4298 (0.62%) were respectively recorded as arrival and departure for sea.

Comparatively, both arrival and departure for the four (4) quarters are elaborated with their rankings below; 4th quarter received the highest in both arrival and departure with values of 193942 (29.06%) and 188603(27.38%) respectively followed by 3rd quarter with arrival as 180394 (27.03%) and departure as 185313 (26.90%), third position was obtained by 2nd quarter with figures of 56687 (23.48) and departure of 165113 (23.97%). 1st quarter received the least in both arrival and departure with figures of 136252(20.42%) and 149791 (21.75%) respectively.

DEPORTATION OF GHANAIS FROM ABROAD

The period under review recorded 924 Ghanaian deportees from abroad. Comparatively, 2008 recorded a higher figure (1344) than 2009 representing 45.45% decline. Forth quarter, 2009 demonstrated the highest value of deportees (253) representing 27.38% followed by first quarter with a figure of 246 indicating 26.62%. Second quarter ranked 3rd representing 24.78% (229) while third quarter recorded the least value of 196 (21.21%).

In general, the month of March recorded the highest figure in deportation of Ghanais from abroad with the least being August.

REPATRIATION OF FOREIGN NATIONALS FROM GHANA

Similarly, the following nationals were repatriated to their respective countries from Ghana during the period under review. Nigerian migrants; accounted for 39.19% as the majority, followed by Liberians and Chinese which obtained 6.76% each, Sri-Lankans 8.11%, Cote D'ivoire 5.41% etc. (see table 15 for details).

OBSERVATIONS

1. IT HAS BEEN OBSERVED THAT SOME OF THE STATISTICAL OFFICERS HAVE BEEN USING DIFFERENT FORMAT TO COMPILE THE STATISTICS WHICH MAKES CONSILIDATION DIFFICULT. IT IS ADVISED THAT, OFFICERS SHOULD STICK TO THE USE OF FORM 14.
2. THE DELAY IN SUBMISSION OF CARDS FROM THE FRONTIERS TO HQ IS DUE TO LATE DELIVERY FROM THE REGIONAL COMMANDS.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. OFFICERS AT THE REGIONAL COMMANDS SHOULD BE READY TO COMPILE AND SUBMIT THE FORM 14 CARDS TO HQ ON TIME.
2. IN ORDER TO IMPROVE PRODUCTIVITY, STATISTICAL COURSES SHOULD BE ORGANISED REGULARLY FOR OFFICERS.

SUMMARY

During the period under review;

- **49% arrivals and 51% departures, accounted for the total migration.**
- **Ghanaian migrants represented 35% (232382) arrivals and 33% (229516) departures.**
- **ECOWAS nationals showed 31% (205604) arrivals and 30% (208148) departures.**
- **Other (Nationals) migrants obtained 34% (229290) arrivals and 37% (250556) departures respectively.**
- **Migration by Air recorded the highest of the distribution for the period under review, obtaining 74.57% out of the total arrivals and 73.68% of the total departures, followed by land with 25.12% arrivals and 25.70% departures. Finally, migration by sea showed 0.30% arrivals and 0.62% departure respectively.**

DATA ANALYSIS AND GRAPHICAL REEPRESENTATIONS

COMPARISON OF NATIONALS WHO WERE FREQUENT IN THE COUNTRY

During compilation and analysis, stratified and cluster sampling techniques were used to select ECOWAS nationals, twenty common and other nationalities for comparison.

The breakdown is demonstrated below;

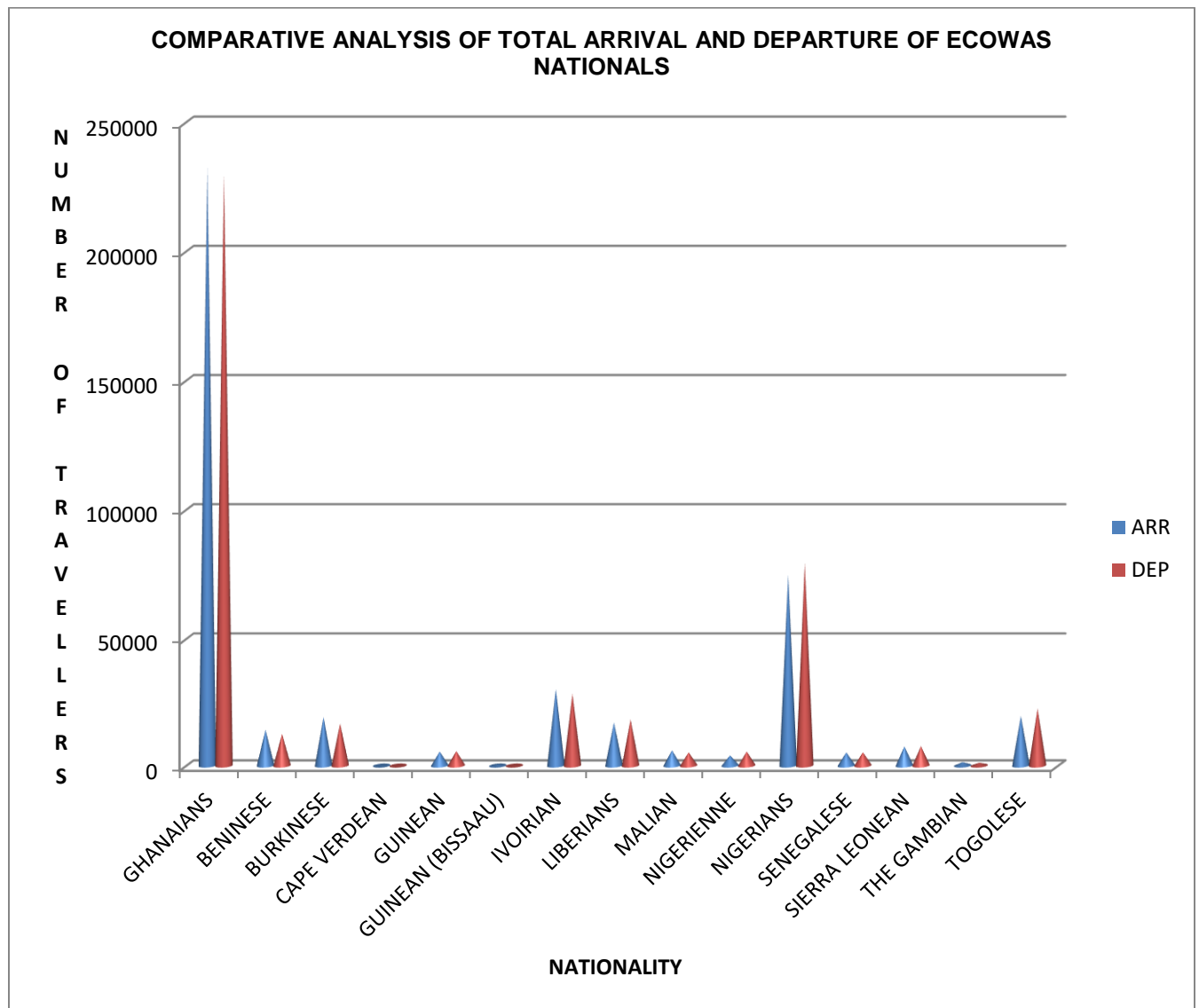

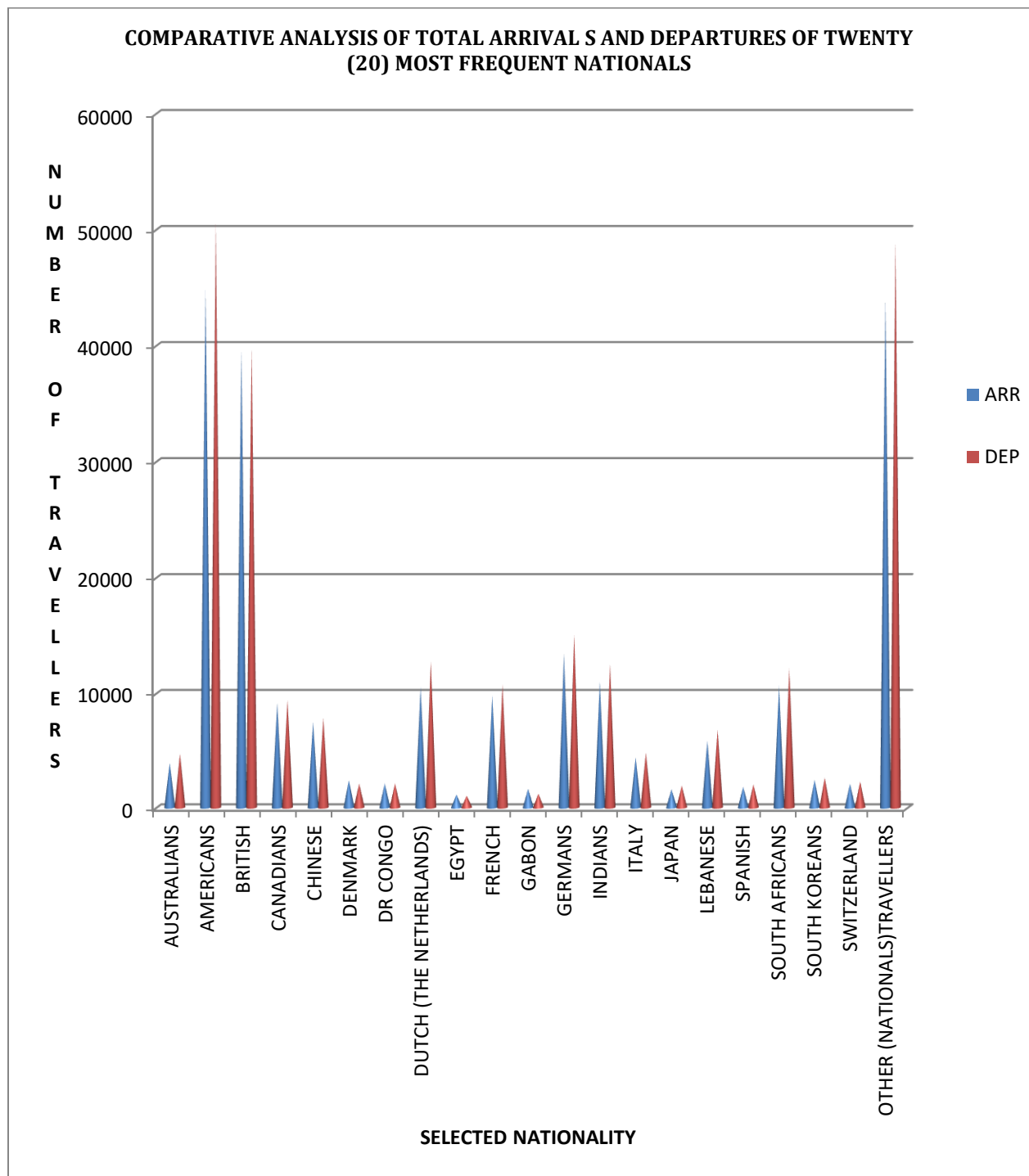

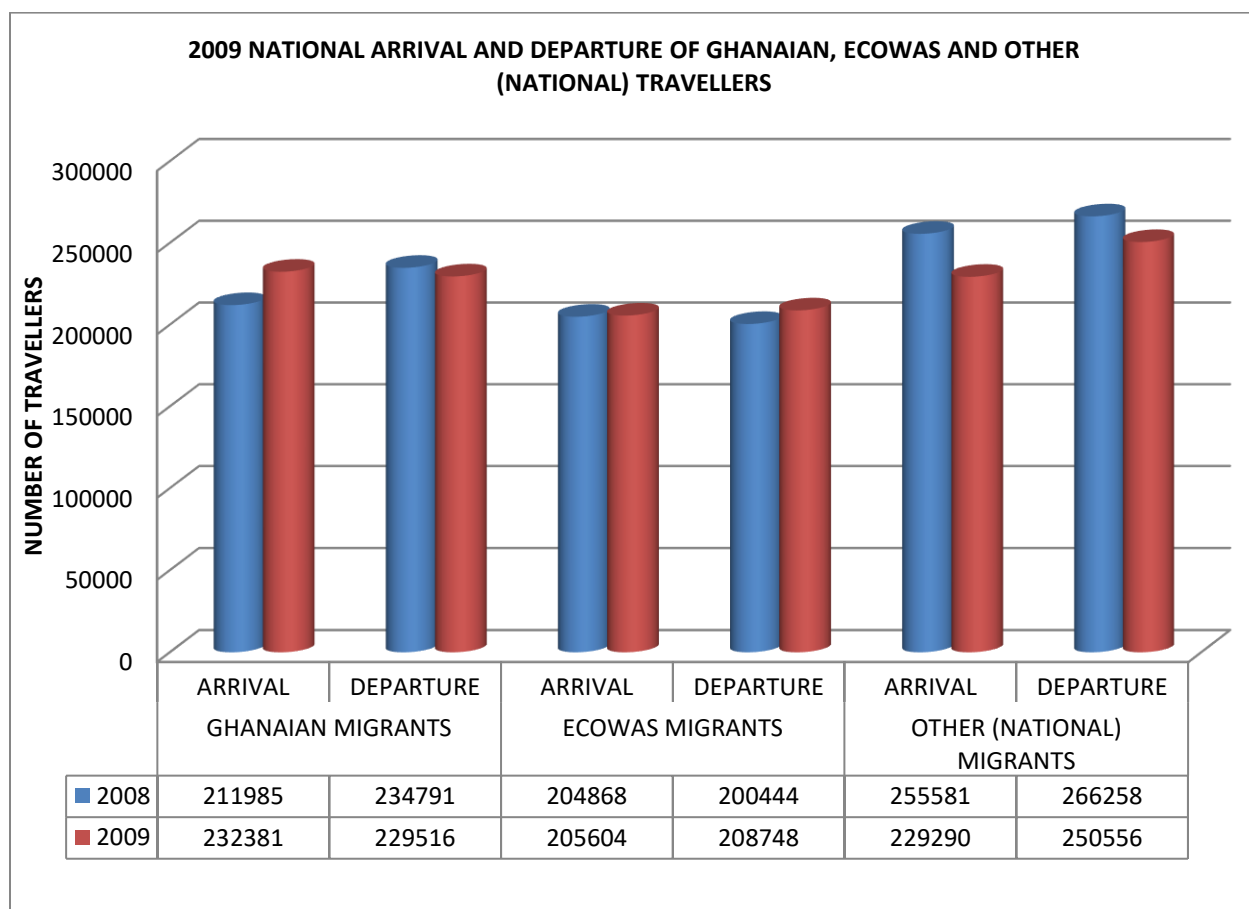

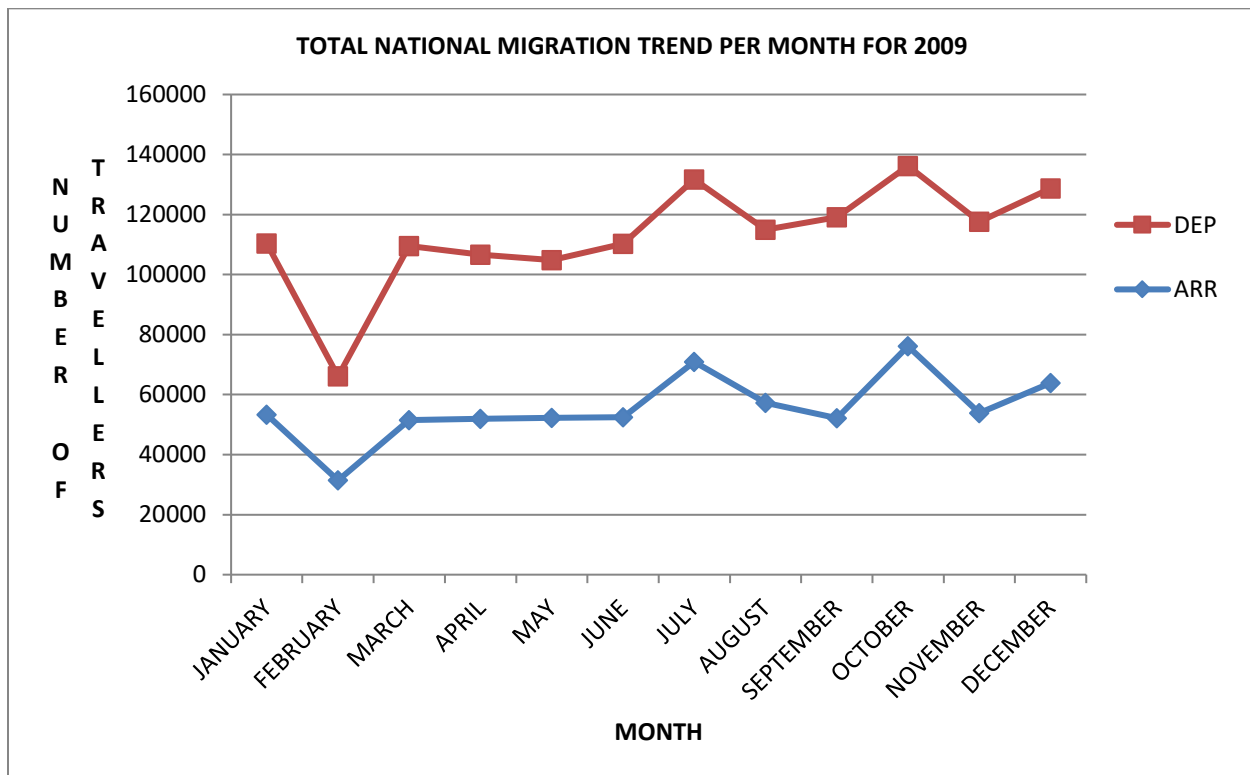

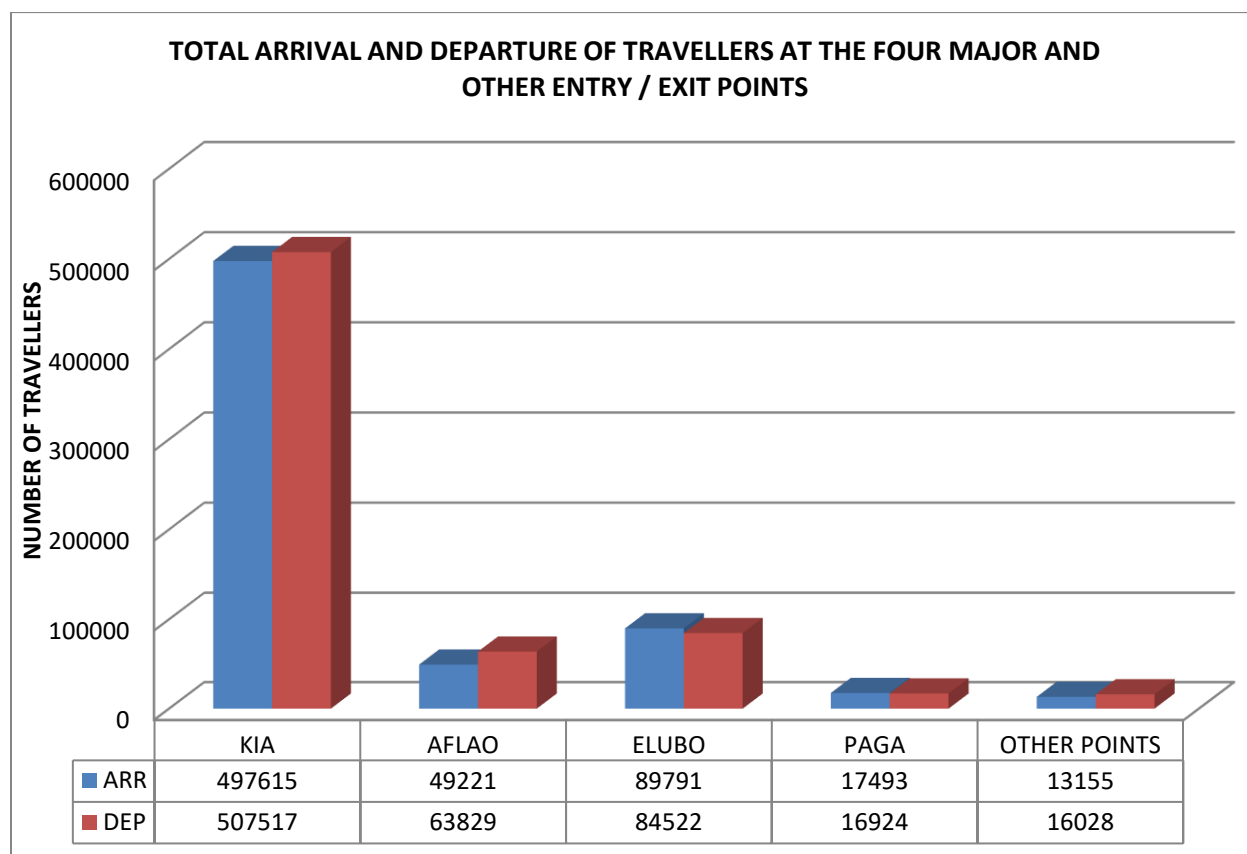

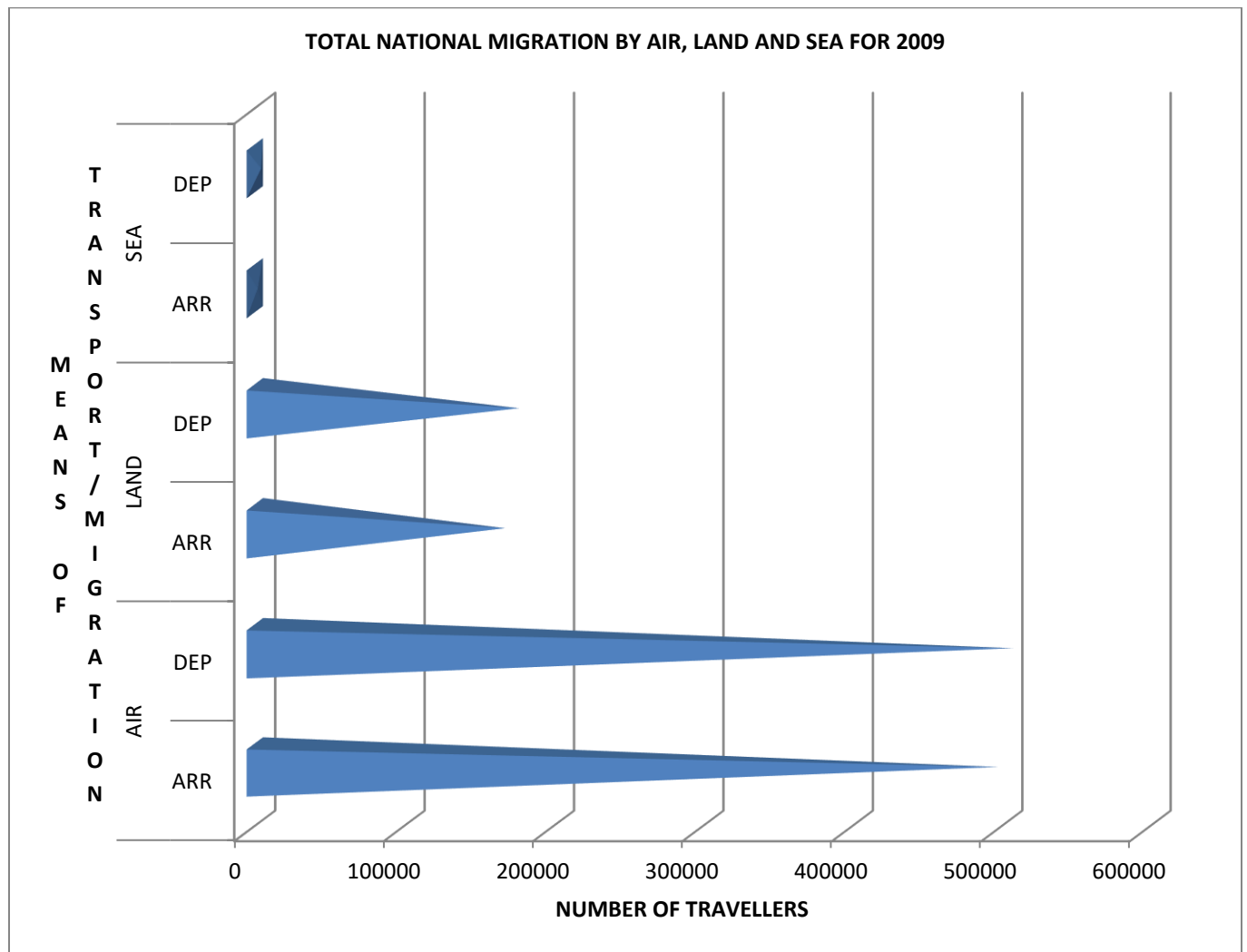

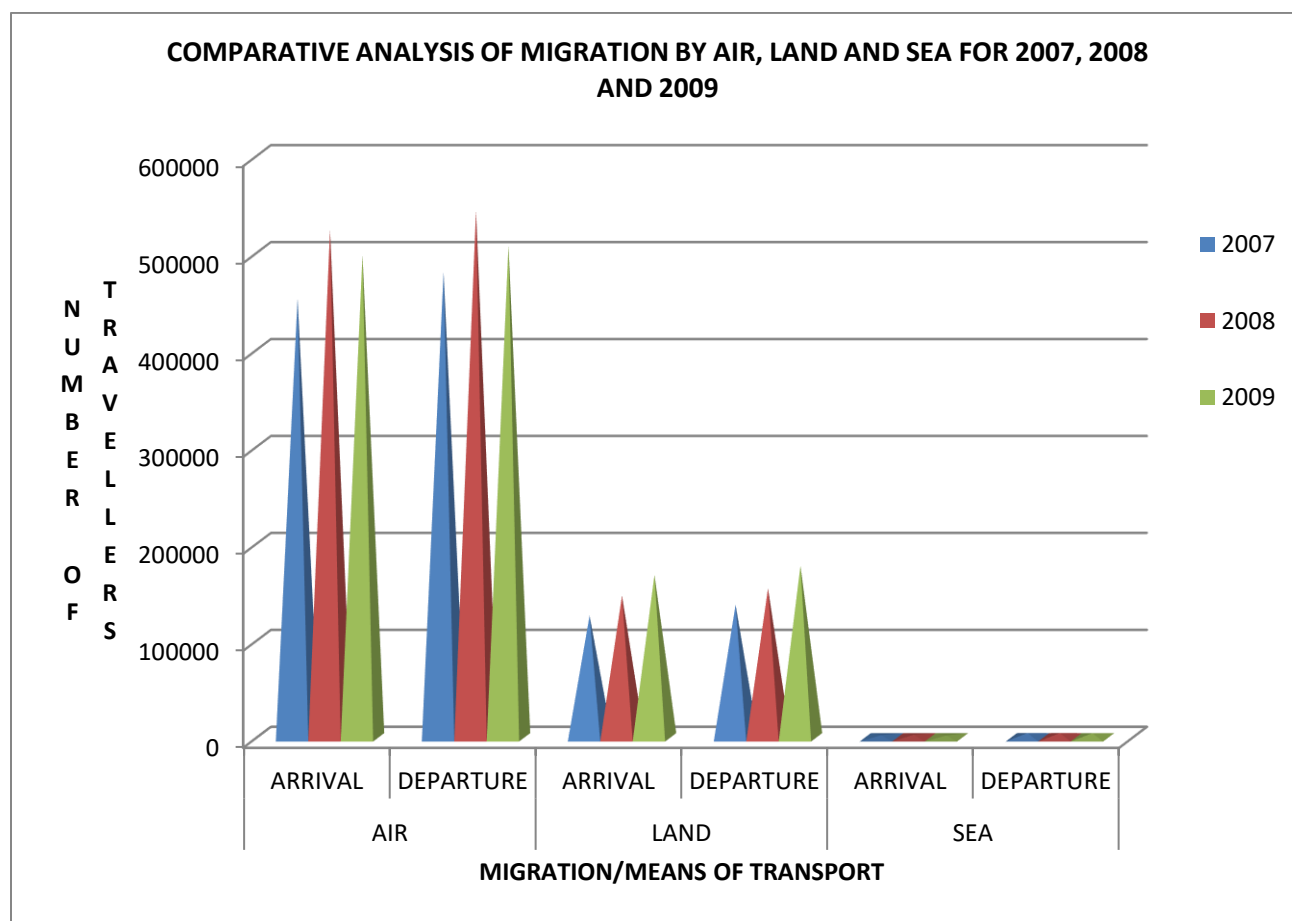

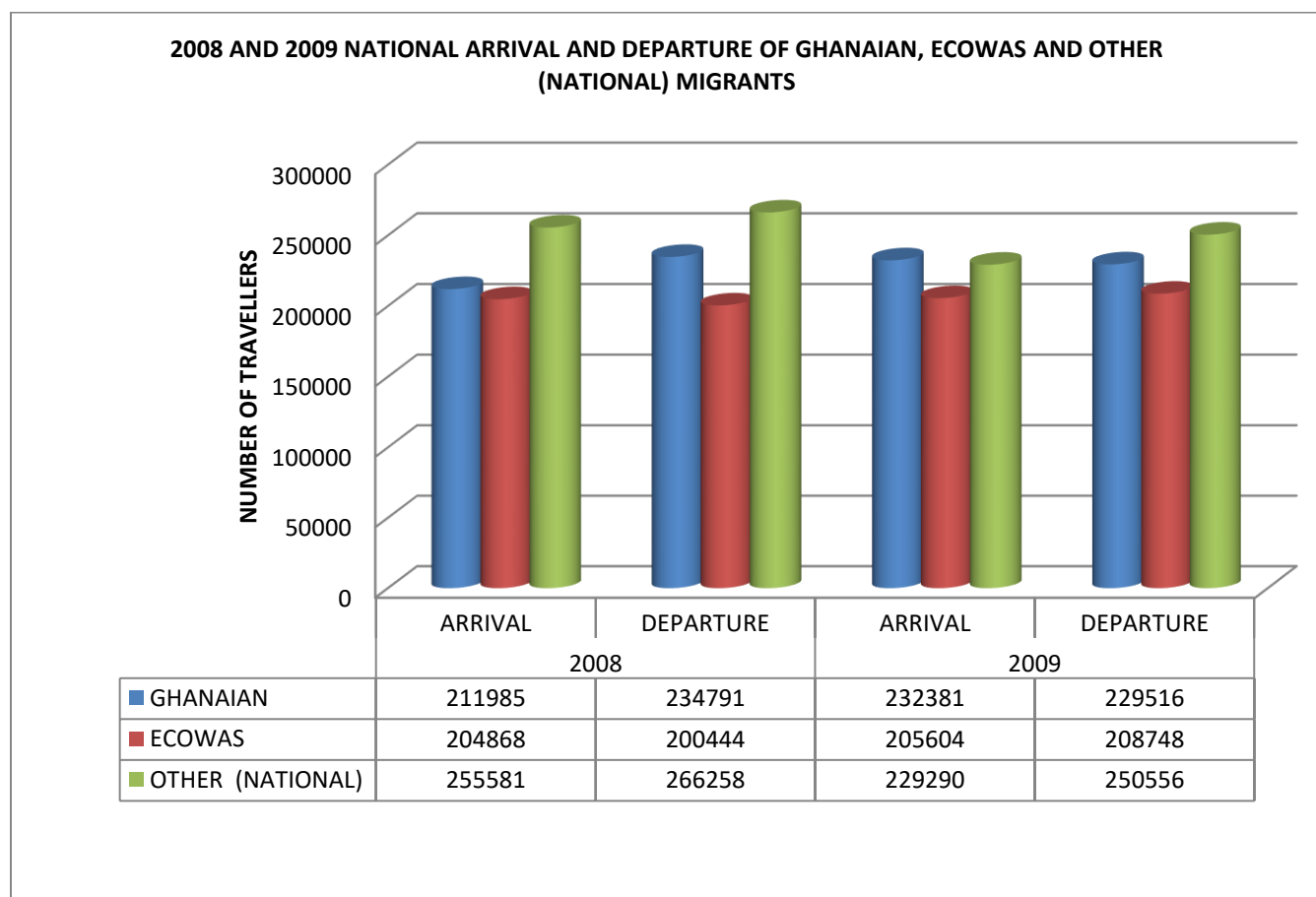

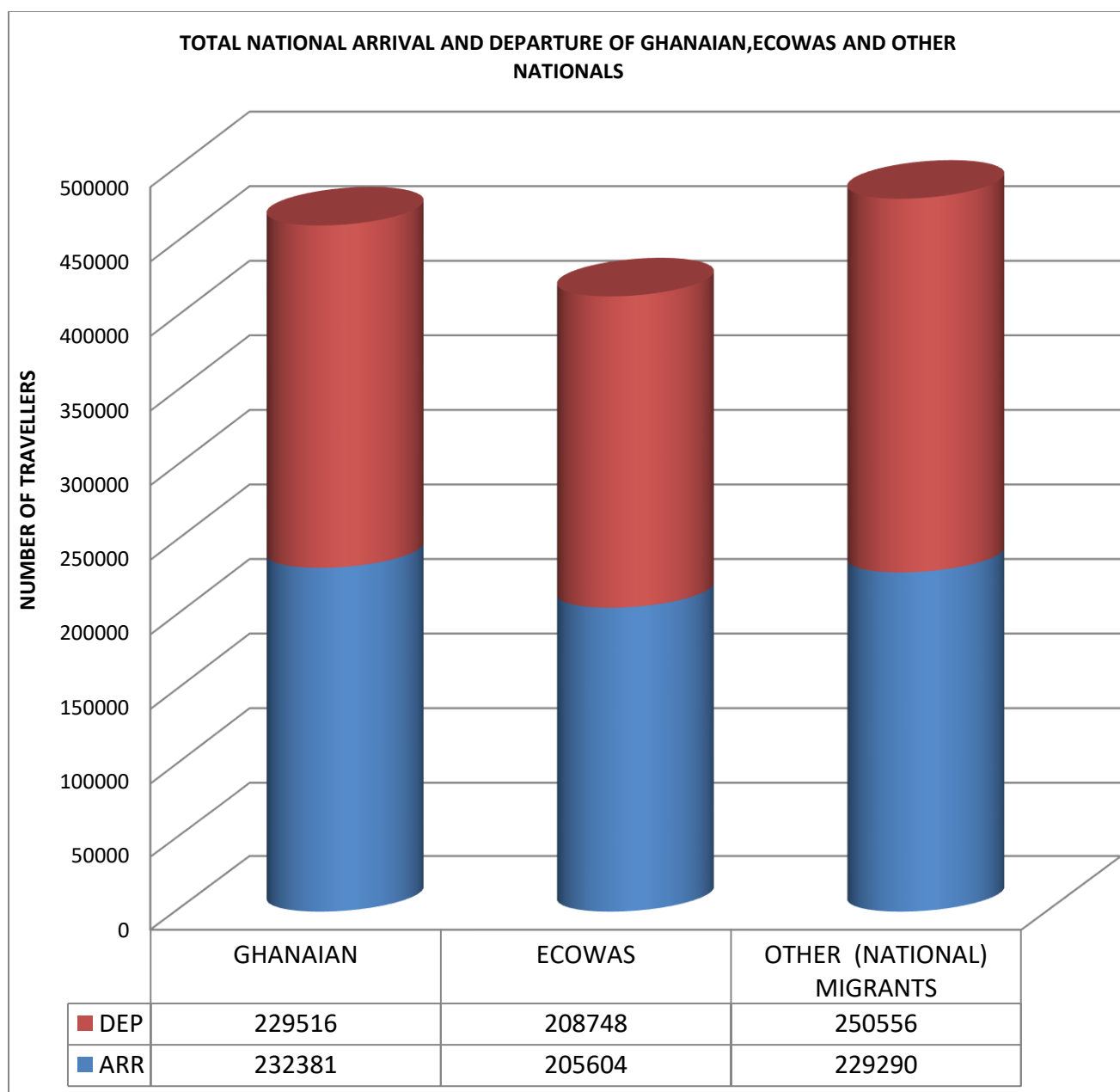

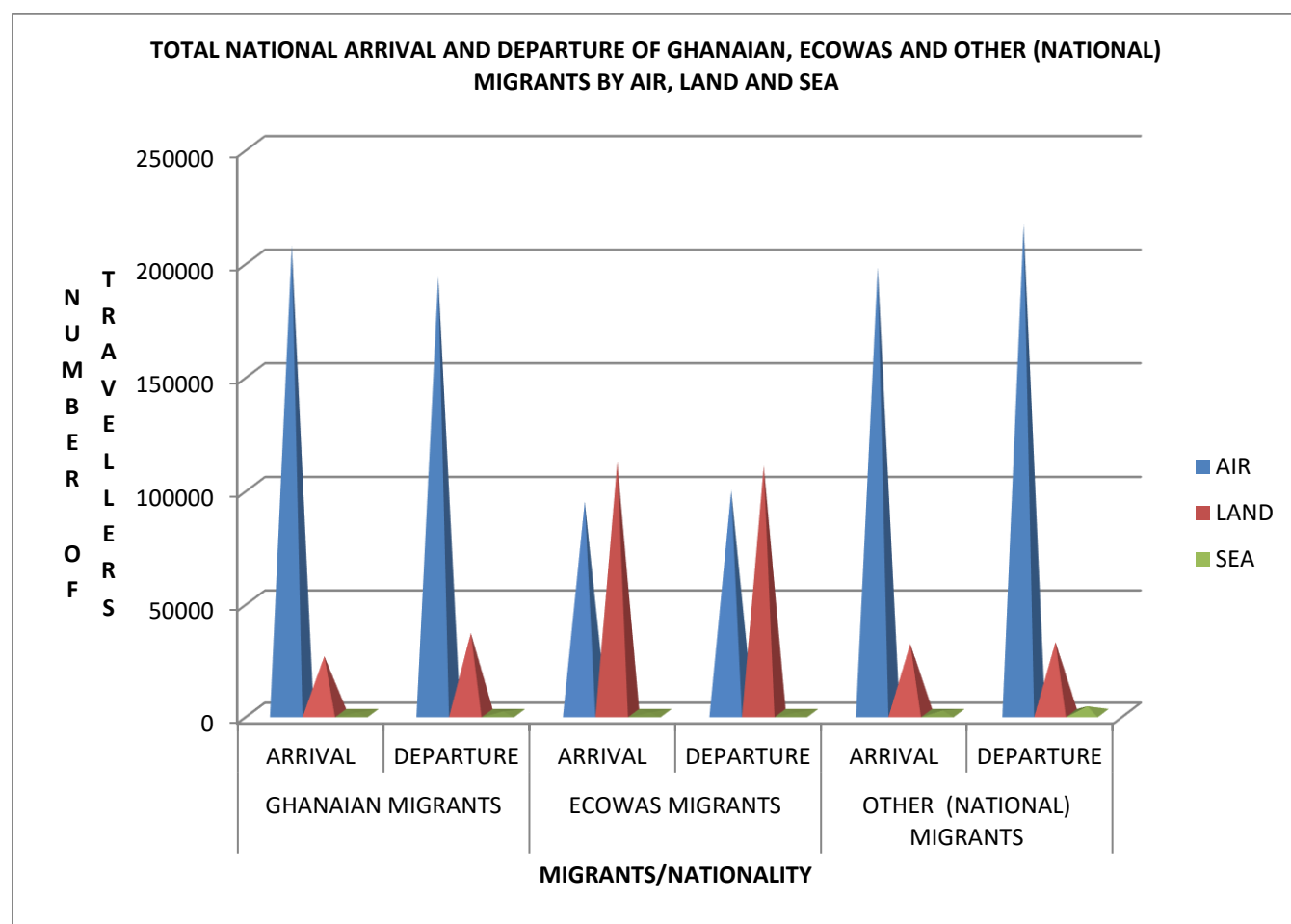

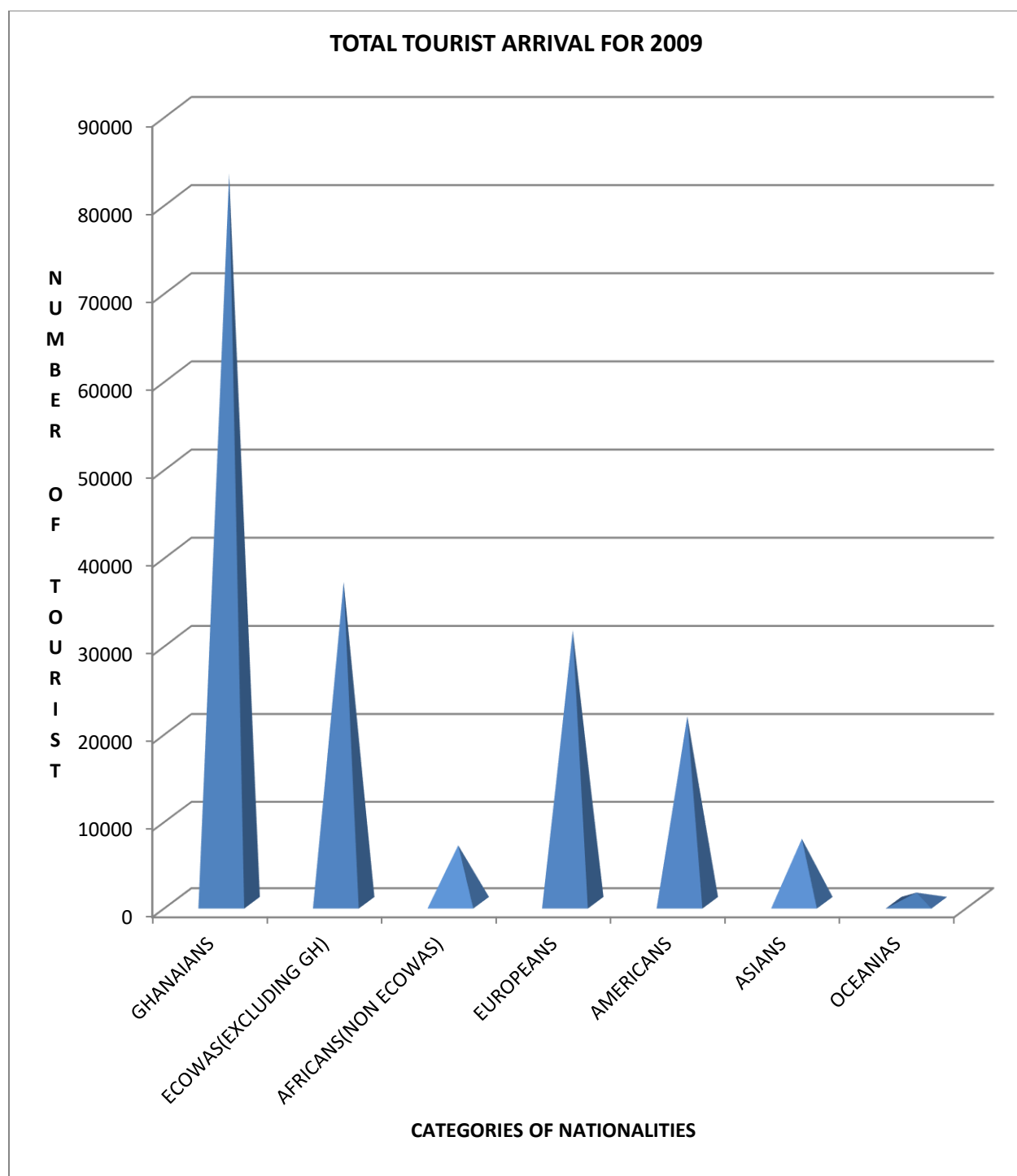

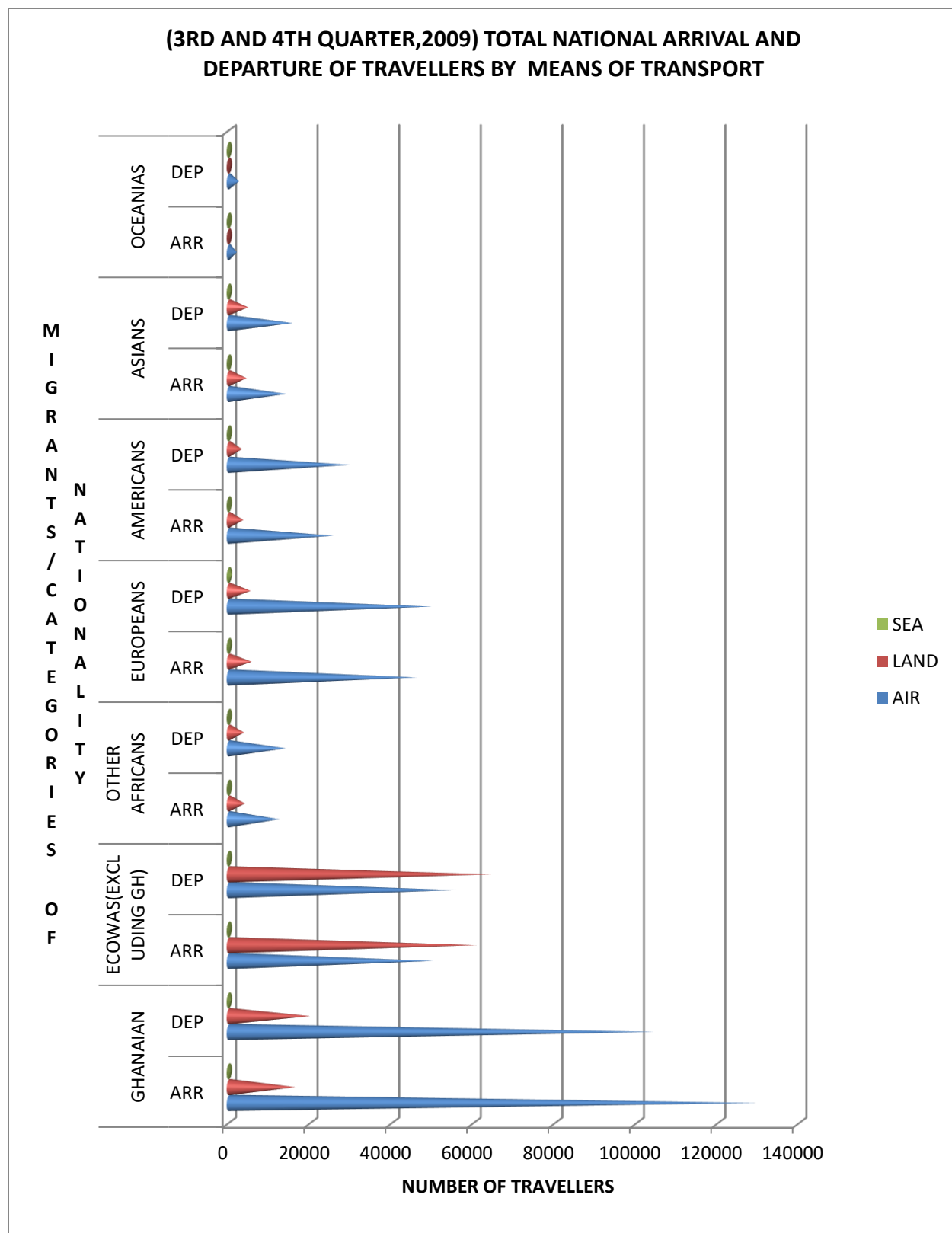

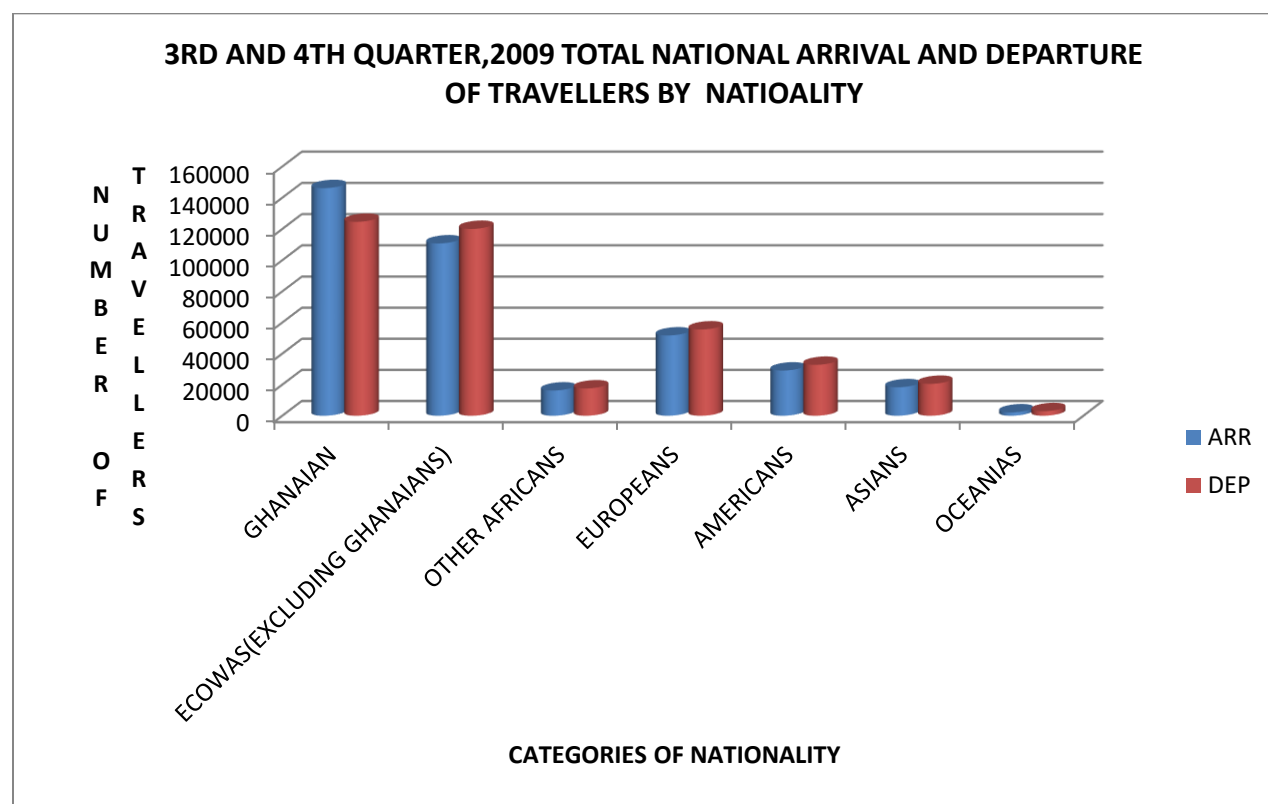

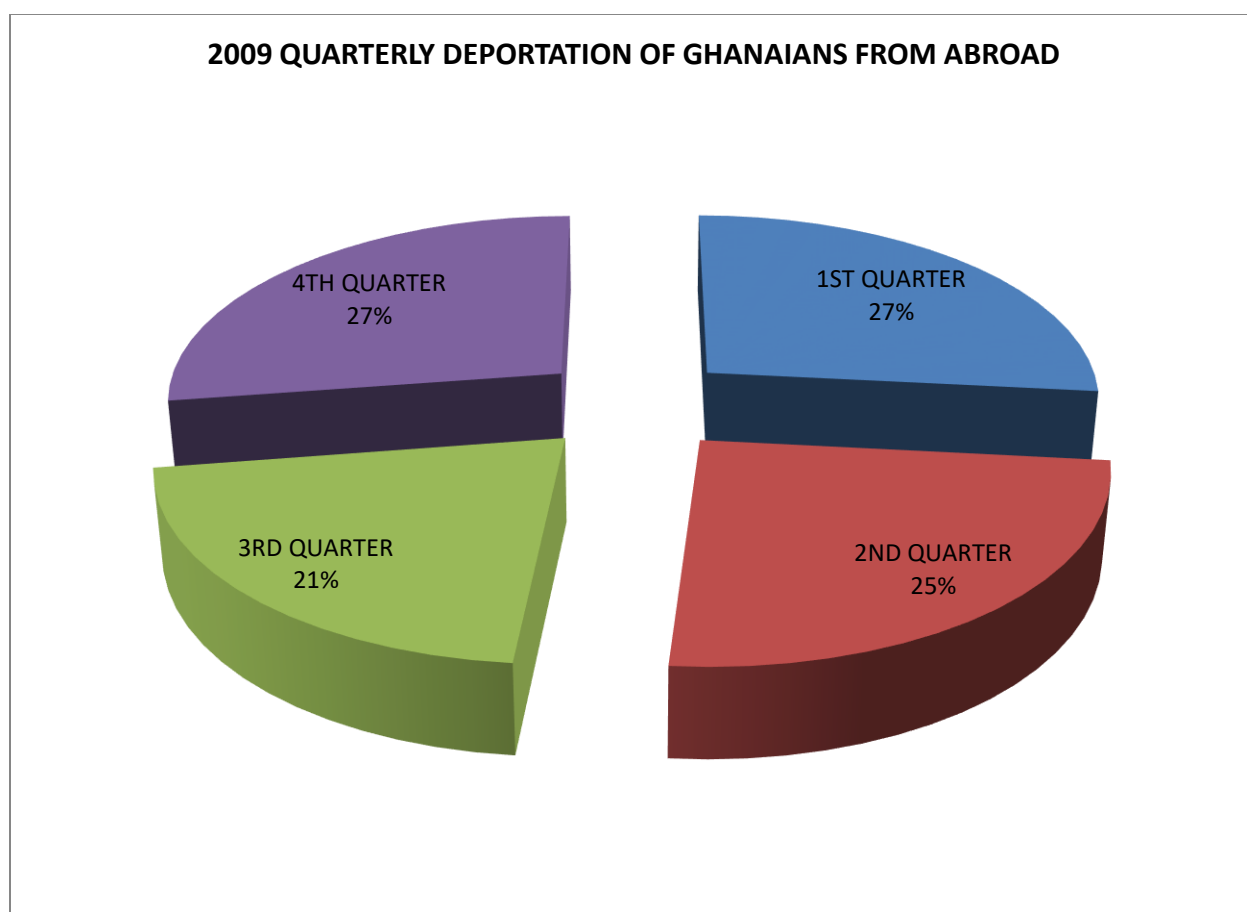

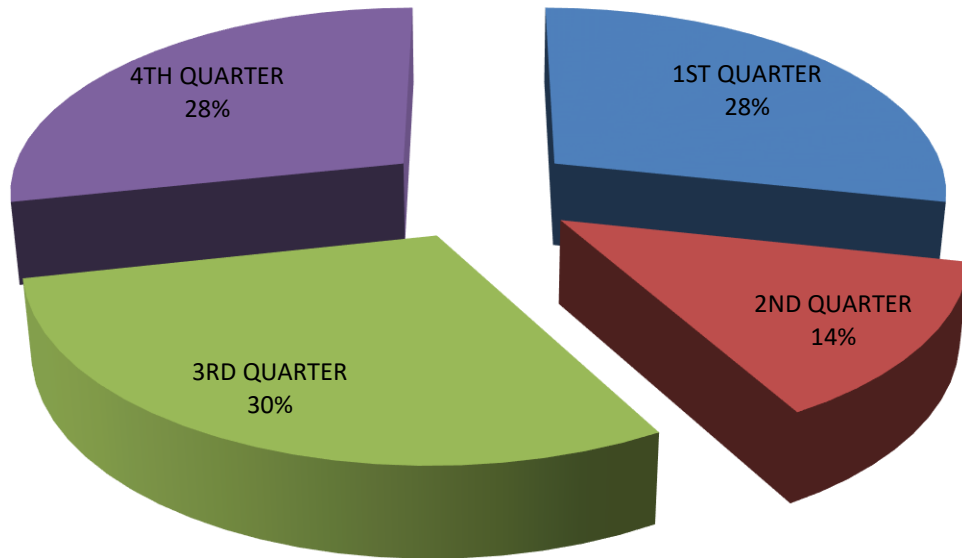
